



BioGeometry Environmental Home Solutions (BG-EHS)
Licensed Independent Associate-Practitioner & Licensed Independent Practitioner
Program Prospectus (2024-2026)

The BioGeometry Environmental Home Solutions (BG-EHS) Program is the official training and licensing program for both the Independent BG-EHS Associate-Practitioner and the Independent BG-EHS Practitioner licenses. The goal of the BG-EHS Program is to train, license and support Associate-Practitioners and Practitioners, who can represent BioGeometry with scientific integrity and ethical professionalism, to provide the highest quality BG-EHS services to the public.

A further fundamental premise for the establishment of the BG-EHS Program is the preservation of the scientific integrity of BioGeometry as a unified body of reasonable and research-based applied knowledge. This necessity emerged a couple of decades ago as BioGeometry was becoming more widespread, and at the same time becoming somewhat vulnerable to dilution, fragmentation, and fraudulent misrepresentation (e.g. fragmented use of BioGeometry intellectual property and scientific terminology, and misappropriation of BioGeometry applied mechanics and research to associate with and support unrelated commercial marketing interests). BG-EHS Licensees are the front-line in representing BioGeometry with integrity and complete transparency, putting limitations before benefits, and in doing so under-promising and over-delivering in the provision of the best quality BG-EHS services to their clients.

BG-EHS Licensed Independent Associate-Practitioners and Licensed Independent Practitioners are both equally integral and valuable members of the BG-EHS Program. All licensees are held to the same set of ethical standards, quality of work and the responsibility to represent BioGeometry and the BG-EHS Program with integrity and responsibility. The Licensed Independent Associate-Practitioner track is not simply an interim step to the Independent Practitioner license, but is a complete licensing opportunity in itself for the offering of the *Introductory* and *Essential* BG-EHS service levels.

BioGeometry environmental home solutions are a core application of the environmental science of BioGeometry. The “home-centric” BG-EHS approach recognizes that our energetic inter-connectivity with our home environments is an integral part of our long-term quality-of-life and wellbeing. The BG-EHS service is a professional evidence-based environmental science offering to enhance the quality of home environments. BioGeometry environmental solutions have proven effective in the harmonization of environmental stress caused by electromagnetic, geopathic, building materials, and structural / design shape-caused disturbances, as well as enhancing water vitality. This is based on the scientific research findings in the BioGeometry Environmental Research Portfolio (*DropBox link below*). BioGeometry environmental home solutions are not a form of medical diagnosis or treatment, but rather are environmental enrichment solutions to improve environmental health.

For over two decades we have been building the BG-EHS Program slowly and steadily, putting quality before quantity, in an effort to ensure that we have the right people, and not just more people in the BG-EHS Program. BG-EHS licensees are expected to adhere to the responsibility of continuous at-home applied skills set development, staying up-to-date with BG-EHS tools and protocol updates, as well as adherence to the standardized service requirements in all BG-EHS services offered to clients.

The BG-EHS Program is open to all students who have completed the BioGeometry personal development curriculum courses [BioGeometry Foundation (FT) & Advanced Foundation (AT)], and processed the knowledge base, concepts, and applied skills, within the private-use / personal development curriculum context of the BioGeometry Student Agreement.

BG-EHS Applied Skills Workshop (ASW)

Prerequisite: BG Advanced Foundation Training (AT) & Being in good standing with the BioGeometry Student Agreement.

The five (5) day in-person BG-EHS Applied Skills Workshop (ASW) is a cross-over course. It is the final stage of the BioGeometry personal development curriculum, following the BioGeometry Foundation (FT) and Advanced Foundation (AT) Trainings. At the same time, the ASW is the prerequisite course for the BG-EHS Licensed Independent Associate-Practitioner Training. The ASW brings the BioGeometry personal development curriculum full-circle with focus on the five pillars of the BG / BG-EHS applied skill set, and empowers students to be able to individually develop that skill set to maximize the utility of their BioGeometry knowledge in their daily lives. This applied skill set is the foundation for successful BG-EHS work, and it is fully covered in the ASW, along with more advanced BG-EHS tools, applications, and protocols. Please note that the ASW is not a BG-EHS license training course, and does not license students for any commercial BioGeometry / BG-EHS work.

BG-EHS Associate-Practitioner Training

Prerequisites: BG-EHS Applied Skills Workshop (ASW) & Being in good standing with the BioGeometry / BG-EHS Student Agreements & Submission and acceptance of the BG-EHS Associate-Practitioner Training Application.

The three (3) day* in-person BG-EHS Associate-Practitioner Training is the professional license training course for those who are interested to move forward as independent BG-EHS licensees, to commercially offer the *Introductory* and *Essential* BG-EHS service levels to the public. This training builds on the foundation BG-EHS Applied Skills Workshop with further applied skill set development, as well as more BG-EHS tools, applications and protocols. There is the expectation that ASW students moving on to the BG-EHS Associate-Practitioner Training have sufficiently applied the work and developed their BG-EHS skill set, in order to successfully complete both the written and applied assessments.

**Applied assessments will commence on the day AFTER the three (3) day BG-EHS Associate-Practitioner Training. Each student will be assigned a time slot to come in for their applied assessment. Testing will take place over two days, which means that half the class will have to wait to be assessed on the following day. Scheduling of the applied assessments is on a first-come first-served basis, with consideration given to out-of-town students when possible.*

BG-EHS Review & Practitioner License Assessment

Prerequisite: Being in good standing BG-EHS Associate-Practitioner License & Submission and acceptance of the BG-EHS Practitioner Application.

Moving from the BG-EHS Associate-Practitioner license to the BG-EHS Practitioner license requires a further application process, as well as written and applied testing, and is not guaranteed. The BG-EHS Practitioner license requirements are primarily performance-based, but there is also more consideration at this stage with regards to responsible and professional representation of the work, as well as to any potential conflicts-of-interest that may pose any risk to the fragmentation or dilution of the science of BioGeometry from individual interests or association with any third-party products or services.

BG-EHS Associate-Practitioner licensees who would like to move to the BG-EHS Practitioner license will need to show that they have applied the BG-EHS work in at least 10 different homes (whether with clients, or privately with family and friends). Upon acceptance of their application, they will need to attend a two (2) day* BG-EHS Review and successfully complete the written and applied BG-EHS Practitioner license requirements.

**Applied assessments will commence on the day AFTER the two (2) day BG-EHS Review. Each student will be assigned a time slot to come in for their applied assessment. Testing will take place over two days, which means that half the class will have to wait to be assessed on the following day. Scheduling of the applied assessments is on a first-come first-served basis, with consideration given to out-of-town students when possible.*

Scope of the BG-EHS Licenses

Subject to the terms and conditions of the *BG-EHS Independent Associate-Practitioner License Agreement*, BG-EHS Associate-Practitioners are granted the right to commercially offer the *Introductory* and *Essential* BG-EHS service levels solely for existing residential homes to end-clients.

Subject to the terms and conditions of the *BG-EHS Independent Practitioner License Agreement*, BG-EHS Practitioners are granted the right to commercially offer the *Introductory*, *Essential*, and *Core* BG-EHS service levels, for existing residential homes to end-clients. Exceptions to widen the scope of the license for projects that fall within the “private office / small business” context are granted on a case-by-case basis.



Larger-scale projects outside of the scope of BG-EHS licenses may be implemented in partnership and collaboration with the *BG-EHS Team*, to ensure the integrity and quality of wider-scale applications, BioGeometry intellectual property rights, as well as to integrate BioGeometry large-scale project protocols, solutions and tools.

It is important to note that BG-EHS licenses are not general BioGeometry practitioner or teaching licenses, but are of specific focus and scope as defined in this prospectus. BG-EHS licenses do not extend to the commercial provision of any BioGeometry surveying or land solutions for large areas, design services, teaching, or any individual healing work.

Any use of the BG-EHS license, including BioGeometry Quality Measurement (BGQM) BG3-based claims, to endorse any other products or services, organizations, or religious or political viewpoints is not tolerated in the BG-EHS Program. If there is any potential conflict of interest in this regard, kindly address that when applying to the BG-EHS Associate-Practitioner Training.

The BG-EHS Business Model

The BG-EHS Licensed Independent Associate-Practitioner and Licensed Independent Practitioner work is based on a viable, but conservative and interim, supplementary income model, and is not intended to be a primary source of income. The BG-EHS business model is structured for independent business practice by licensees, and some business skills are necessary to create awareness and build a client base. Licensees are permitted to market their services using the BG-EHS logo on their own marketing material and websites, and are recognized and listed for client referrals on the BG-EHS webpage on the official BioGeometry website. Licensees are also permitted to give talks and presentations, within the parameters outlined in the trainings and license agreements, to promote their BG-EHS services.

BG-EHS tools are available to Associate-Practitioners & Practitioners at a benchmarked 20% discount from BG AT retail prices, with no minimum purchase requirements. The annual license and BG-EHS Program fee is USD\$99.

Term & Renewal of BG-EHS Licenses

The term of both the BG-EHS Licensed Independent Associate-Practitioner and Licensed Independent Practitioner license agreements is six (6) years. Renewal is based on being in good standing with regards to the respective BG-EHS license agreement, as well as attendance of a two (2) day in-person BG-EHS Review, and successful completion of the written and applied assessments. This renewal requirement must be completed in either year five (5) or six (6) of the active license period to renew for another six (6) years.
